ROMANS 1:17 "God is revealed from faith to faith... the just shall live by faith."

II CORINTHIANS 5:7 "... we walk by faith not by sight." (Hebrews 2:8; Matthew 5:34)

ROMANS 10:17 "... faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God..."

MARK 4:24 "... Take heed what you hear. With the same measure you use it will be measured back to you..." (Proverbs 4:1, 10, 20-22; Galatians 6:9)

HEBREWS 11:1, 3 "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.... By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the Word of God so that the things which are seen were not made of the things which are visible." (John 1:1-5; Genesis 1:1; Romans 1:17, 20)

HEBREWS 11:6 "Without faith it is impossible to please God for he who comes to God must believe: (a) that He IS (Exodus 3:14), and (b) He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him." (Matthew 6:33)

ROMANS 4:2 "... the Word which they heard did not profit them not being mixed with faith in those who heard It." (Romans 10:17; Mark 4:13-20)

PHILIPPIANS 4:4-7 "Rejoice in the Lord always. Again, I say rejoice! Let your gentleness be known to all men, the Lord is at hand. Be anxious for nothing; but in everything, by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, let your requests made known to God and the peace of God, which surpasses all (human) understanding will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."

PSALM 37:4-7 "Delight yourself also in the Lord and He shall give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the Lord. Trust also in Him and He shall bring it to pass.... Rest in the Lord and wait patiently for Him."

ISAIAH 40:29, 31 "(God) gives power to the weak and to those who have no might He increases strength.... But, those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength. They shall mount up with wings like eagles. They shall run and not grow weary. They shall walk and not faint." (Psalm 27:14; Psalm 103 1-5)

NEHEMIAH 8:10 "... the joy of the Lord is your strength...." (Ephesians 6:10-18)

PHILIPPIANS 4:11-13 "... I have learned in whatever state I am to be content: I know how to live humbly and I know how to live in prosperity. Everywhere, and in all things, I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and suffer need. I can do all things through Christ Who strengthens me."

PSALM 16:11 "... in Your presence is fullness of joy." (John 15:11)

JAMES 1:2-4 "My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials and

tribulations knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience (or endurance, or perseverance). But, let patience have its perfect work that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing."

ROMANS 5:3-4 "... we also glory in tribulation knowing that tribulation produces perseverance (or, endurance), and perseverance character, and character hope."

ISAIAH 55:11 "... My Word that goes forth from My mouth. It shall not return to Me void but It shall accomplish what I please and It shall prosper in the thing for which I sent It."

MATTHEW 18:18-20 "Assuredly I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in Heaven and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in Heaven. Again, I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask it will be done for them by My Father in Heaven for where two or three are gathered together in My Name I am there in the midst of them."

EPHESIANS 6:10-18 "Finally, my brethren, put on the whole armor of God that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil for we do not wrestle with flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.
